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When: All submissions must be emailed, **by the student**, to Dr. Ro, Director of Education, at dro@thekensingtongroup.org on or before **January 5, 2020**. **Subject Line:** Youth Summit Arts Enrichment Contest. All winners will be notified by **January 10, 2020**. Only one winner will be selected for each category. Each winner will receive a scholarship towards college/secondary tuition, music/art lessons, educational resources **AND** perform at the Summit.

Guidelines: Your creation must illustrate **one** of the following categories:

- Visual Art (pencil drawing, video, any medium on canvas, etc.)
- Music Performance—instrumental (3-minute video)
- Music Performance—vocal (3-minute video)
- Literary (speech, essay, recite poem, etc.) (3-minute video)

Submission Groups:

- Grades 6-8 (Visual, Instrumental, Vocal, Literary)
- Grades 9-12 (Visual, Instrumental, Vocal, Literary)

You must be registered to attend the Summit to participate. Please be tasteful and artful in your use of mature themes such as drugs, sex, nudity, or violence; however, we want your authentic voice to be heard. You may only submit for one category: **Visual Art, Instrumental, Vocal or Literary Art.**

If you are submitting a visual art piece or series, we require some form of artist's statement or rationale (to be published alongside the work). Any visual art sent without this will not be considered. All artwork must be submitted as a jpeg or pdf file.
